

141st St. & SR37 Intersection Update












Happening Now: 141st St. & SR37

- Utility work has already begun and will continue through Spring of next year.
- Gas, sanitary, electric, water and communication lines are actively being relocated for the start of construction next year.
- 141st will be "let" (request for bids) in the Fall of 2023

Happening Next: 141st St. & SR37


- An interim phase to improve traffic flow at 141st St and SR37 and prepare for further construction will be put in place as early as the winter break until the next phase
- The Hamilton Southeastern Schools and Emergency Services have been coordinated with on this interim phase and accommodations are being coordinated to minimize impacts.
- The stoplights will be removed and 141st St. will transition to a Right-In Right-Out configuration.
- This will not be the final configuration, this is a pre-construction phase to be in place until the project is let and bids are accepted in Fall of 2023.








